Welcome to Preschool!

Whether preschool is a new experience for you or a familiar process, you will need to know what supplies your child needs to bring to school. Most supplies are provided by the program, but we also request that each family provide some classroom and personal items. Below is a list of items that should be brought to your child's open house. You will receive information about this event closer to the beginning of the school year.

CLASS ITEMS:

- 2 boxes of wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 box of sandwich-size Ziploc Bags
- 1 box of gallon-size Ziploc Bags
- 6 or more Elmer glue sticks (We use these a lot!)
- 1 pack of Play Doh
- 1 1 ½ inch white binder

***PERSONAL ITEMS:**

- 1 set of extra clothes in a Ziploc bag marked with your child's name. Please include socks and an extra pair of shoes if available.
- 1 blanket for rest time (Please, no pillows).
- Full-size book bag big enough to carry a folder, and two, two-pocket folders to send communication home.

*Personal items, including clothing, need to be clearly marked with your child's name. **Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.**

At preschool, we try to help children become more independent and have higher self-esteem. We need your help to make this happen. **One important thing you can do is dress your child in clothing they can fasten and unfasten on their own.** Also, we are very active throughout the day; therefore, please have your child wear comfortable shoes to school. Dress shoes and flip-flops are very hard to run and play in, especially on our playground.
