Home School - What is it?

When a parent/legal guardian home schools their child, it means they manage **all aspects** of the child's educational experience rather than sending their child to school.

Important Details

- * Parents must provide 900 hours of instruction.
- * Parents must keep all records of child's education.
- * Parents must provide an assessment of students work.
- * Parents must notify school districts every year.

Follow these steps to become a home-school family.

1.

Meet with school district to consider all educational options prior to making the decision to home school.

Search for a curriculum that best suits the needs of your child and family.



5.

Begin educating your child/children.
