## The Application Process

The River View Local School District Board of Education is looking for a dedicated fiscal leader who will be student-centered, and committed to our financial stability. The treasurer will replace our former treasurer. There have been only three treasurers in the district's history dating back to 1965.

## The River View Local School District and Community

The River View Local School District is located in southeastern Ohio. The district is part of Coshocton County with a population of approximately 36,900. The county is geographically large covering 564 square miles. The River View District covers 376 square miles of the county. The area is known for its rural, country setting, which is popular for hunting, farming, and a laid-back atmosphere. Coshocton is a small town with shops and restaurants on Main Street. The community also includes a restored canal town known as Roscoe Village, and a top-notch aquatic recreation park complex called Lake Park. The district is conveniently located midway between Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and Columbus, Ohio, and within a 20-minute drive of I-77 and 40 minutes from I-70. Coshocton is situated along the State Route 16/US Route 36 corridor, which is a four-lane highway connecting Columbus and I-77. Coshocton County's location provides numerous opportunities to drive a short distance to visit popular destinations including Columbus, Cleveland, Akron/Canton, and Ohio's Amish Country.

River View Local School District takes pride in our high academic standards and student achievements. We promote up-to-date technology, gifted programming, visual and performing arts, college credit plus, general courses and more. The district consists of five (5) buildings with three (3) elementaries (Pre-K to 6th Grade), one (1) junior high, and one (1) high school. The total enrollment is nearly 1,770 students.

The River View Local School District has a rich history, and many community partners support our schools and students. The district has partnered with many organizations to provide opportunities for both staff and students including, but not limited to: Teen Leadership Corp, United Way of Coshocton, River View Foundation, Coshocton Foundation, Montgomery Foundation, The Engle Scholarship through The Ohio State University, Frontier Power Cooperative, ODNR, Coshocton CARES, Coshocton Behavioral Health Choices, and Coshocton County Job & Family Services. All these organizations help provide opportunities and experiences for growth and development.

The planned instruction and learning experiences are designed in a continuous, sequential program of instruction, to help meet the needs of the whole child: mentally, physically, emotionally, and socially.*

At River View Local, our highly-qualified staff provides a high quality education for all students. From providing the latest philosophy through the science of reading, dyslexia training for teachers, providing gifted and talented services to special education services, to having a mental health counselor in each building, our schools provide an excellent educational experience each day. The music program has been a staple in our district for many years from elementary to high school programs.

At River View High School, students can access nine CCP on-campus classes along with an award-winning FFA Program. The high school also offers courses in business and computer science throughout the day, plus a Mentoring Program where students job shadow professionals for a semester. Teen Leadership Corp is also active at the high school giving students an opportunity to advance their leadership skills and community service. We are also affiliated with Coshocton Youth Leadership, Coshocton County Career Center, Buckeye Career Center, Mid-East Career Center and C-Tech Career Center for students looking for a specific career program.

River View Local Schools has been and will be the educational leader in the region. The district has evolved over the years as enrollment has declined. The district has maintained its level of excellence in educating the youth of the district, while attracting high quality candidates for all positions in the district. We look forward to the opportunity to serve our students and this community in the coming years.

## The Future

The district is working through a reconfiguration plan to consolidate five buildings into three. We currently have three elementary schools, one junior high, and one high school. In the 2023-2024 school year, we will consolidate into a Pre-K to Second Grade building, a Third to Sixth Grade Intermediate School, and a Seventh to Twelfth Grade High School. These moves are being made because of loss of enrollment, aging neighborhood elementary buildings, and a desire to maximize resources within the district. We are also exploring the idea of constructing a new elementary school in the next five years.



## Salary and Terms of Employment

The River View Local School District will offer the successful candidate a multi-year contract. The salary and benefits will be competitive within the region and commensurate with experience and qualifications.
