Welcome to Preschool!

Whether preschool is a new experience for you or a familiar process, you will need to know what supplies your child needs to bring to school. Most supplies are provided by the program, but we also request that each family provide some classroom and personal items. Below is a list of items that should be brought to your child's open house. **\*Please bring these items with you in a trash bag labeled with child's name\***

### Class Items:

- 1 pack of 3 Clorox wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 pack of playdoh
- 1 pack of fine tip dry erase markers (black)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 pack of baby wipes
- **Girls** – 1 box of quart size Ziplock bags
- **Boys** – 1 box of gallon size Ziplock bags

### \* PERSONAL ITEMS:

1 two-pocket **plastic** folder

1 inch three-ring binder

1 crayon box (1 box of crayons, 3 purple glue sticks, scissors)

Child size blanket (no pillows)

1 set of extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks) **labeled in a Ziplock Bag**

**Regular size** backpack to carry pictures and homework

\*Personal items, including clothing, need to be clearly marked with your child's name. **Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.**

At preschool, we try to help children become more independent and have higher self-esteem. We need your help to make this happen. **One important thing you can do is dress your child in clothing they can fasten and unfasten on their own.** Also, we are very active throughout the day; therefore, please have your child wear comfortable shoes to school. Dress shoes and flip-flops are very hard to run and play in, especially on the playground.
