Welcome to Preschool!

Whether preschool is a new experience for you or a familiar process, you will need to know what supplies your child needs to bring to school. Below is a list of items that should be brought to your child's screening. You will receive information about this event closer to the beginning of the school year.

CLASS ITEMS:

- 1 Box of Tissues
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 2 Containers of Clorox Wipes
- 2 Roll of Paper Towels
- 1 Three-Ring Binder (**1 or 1 ½ inch**)
- Washable Markers
- Crayons
- Glue sticks (3)
- Playdoh (2 Cans)
- Quart or gallon size ziploc baggies

**NO ZIPPER OR VELCRO
CLOSURES**

- 1 Two-Pocket Folder (**not a paper one**, it will be used all year, plastic ones seem to last)
- Water Bottle (Leakproof) (No sippy cups please) These will be used for WATER ONLY, please don't send bottle with anything but water.

***PERSONAL ITEMS: Please label with child's name.**

- Child-size Blanket (**no pillows please**)
- Extra Clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks, pull-ups if needed) Please keep in mind the weather when providing these clothes.
- **Full-size** Backpack to hold a 2-pocket folder, schoolwork and blanket (which will be sent home every Friday to be washed and returned on Tuesday Morning).

*Personal items, including clothing, need to be clearly marked with your child's name. **Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.**

At preschool, we try to help children become more independent and have higher self-esteem. We need your help to make this happen. **One important thing you can do is dress your child in clothing they can fasten and unfasten on their own.** Also, we are very active throughout the day; therefore, please have your child wear comfortable shoes to school. Dress shoes and flip-flops are very hard to run and play in, especially on our playground.
