Welcome to Preschool!

Whether preschool is a new experience for you or a familiar process, you will need to know what supplies your child needs to bring to school. Most supplies are provided by the program, but we also request that each family provide some classroom and personal items. Below is a list of items that should be brought to your child's open house. You will receive information about this event closer to the beginning of the school year.

#### **CLASS ITEMS:**

- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 three ring 1" binder (labeled with child's name)
- 1 composition notebook (labeled with child's name)
- 1 pack of fine tip dry erase markers (black)
- 1 pack of play dough
- 1 pack of gallon sized ziplock baggies
- 1 pack of quart sized ziplock baggies
- 1 box of tissues

#### **\*PERSONAL ITEMS:**

1 child-sized blanket

extra clothes- shirt, pants, socks, underwear (placed in Ziplock baggie labeled with name)

**Full-size** back pack to hold a folder, schoolwork, and blanket.

\*Personal items, including clothing, need to be clearly marked with your child's name. **Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.**

In preschool, we try to help children become more independent and have higher self-esteem. We need your help to make this happen. **One important thing you can do is dress your child in clothing they can fasten and unfasten on their own.** Also, we are very active throughout the day; therefore, please have your child wear comfortable shoes to school. Dress shoes and flip-flops are very hard to run and play in, especially on our playground.
