Welcome to Preschool!

Whether preschool is a new experience for you or a familiar process, you will need to know what supplies your child needs to bring to school. Most supplies are provided by the program, but we also request that each family provide some classroom and personal items. Below is a list of items that should be brought to your child's open house. You will receive information about this event closer to the beginning of the school year.

CLASS ITEMS:

- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 three ring 1" binder (labeled with child's name)
- 2 notebooks (labeled with child's name)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of baby wipes (used to wipe our hands after activities)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 crayon box
- 1 pack of glue sticks (at least a 2-pack)
- 1 scissors
- 1 folder

*PERSONAL ITEMS:

1 small blanket (**PLEASE** do **NOT** send the thick blankets that don't fold well. This needs to be small enough to fold & place in a small cubby space.)

Extra Clothes- shirt, pants, socks, underwear (placed in Ziplock baggie labeled with name)

Full-size bookbag large enough to hold a folder, coat, schoolwork, and blanket.

*Personal items, including clothing, need to be clearly marked with your child's name. **Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.**

In preschool, we try to help children become more independent and have higher self-esteem. We need your help to make this happen. **One important thing you can do is dress your child in clothing they can fasten and unfasten on their own.** Also, we are very active throughout the day; therefore, please have your child wear comfortable shoes to school. Dress shoes and flip-flops are very hard to run and play in, especially on our playground.
