Most supplies are provided by the program, but we also request that each family provide some classroom and personal items. Below is a list of items that should be brought to your child's open house. You will receive information about this event closer to the beginning of the school year.

CLASS ITEMS:

- 2 - boxes of tissues
- 1 - container of Clorox wipes
- 1 - pack of markers
- 2 - boxes of baby wipes
- 1 - container of hand sanitizer
- 1 - three-ring binder
- 4 - glue sticks
- 1 – plastic folder with prongs
- 1 – package of Play Dough
- 1 - package of construction paper

PERSONAL ITEMS: Please label with child's name.

- Child-size Blanket.
- Extra Clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks, pull-ups if needed).
- Regular size backpack to hold a 2-pocket folder, schoolwork, and blanket.

Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.

At preschool, we try to help children become more independent and have higher self-esteem. We need your help to make this happen. **One important thing you can do is dress your child in clothing they can fasten and unfasten on their own.** Also, we are very active throughout the day; therefore, please have your child wear comfortable shoes to school. Dress shoes and flip-flops are very hard to run and play in.
