
Welcome to Preschool

- 1 set of extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks, pull-ups if needed) labeled in a Ziplock Bag

- \* Personal items, including clothing, need to be clearly marked with your child's name. <u>Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.</u>
