

# Virtual OTES 2.0 New Evaluator Credential Training

## Get Credentialed to Serve as an Evaluator of Teachers

OTES 2.0 Evaluator Training prepares individuals who evaluate teachers in a Local Educational Agency (LEA) to conduct effective, high-quality, and consistent teacher evaluations using the OTES 2.0 framework. To become a credentialed teacher evaluator in the State of Ohio, participants must hold the appropriate licensure or be approved by their LEA as a peer evaluator, complete the required three-day state-sponsored training, and successfully pass an online credentialing assessment. Full attendance for all three days is required. After completing the training, participants will receive access to the online assessment needed to earn their evaluator credential.
