Welcome to Preschool!

Whether preschool is a brand-new experience or something familiar to your family, it's important to know which supplies your child will need for school. While most materials are provided by the program, we ask each family to contribute a few classroom and personal items. Below is a list of supplies to bring to your child's open house. Additional details about the open house will be shared closer to the start of the school year.

Class items:

- 2 - boxes of tissues
- 2 - containers of Clorox/Lysol wipes
- 1 - roll of paper towels
- 1 - 2" three-ring binder (your child will receive this back at the end of the school year with lots of fun activities we have done throughout the year)
- 1 - plastic folder with pockets

Personal items: Please label with your child's name.

- Child-size blanket for rest time
- A water bottle
- Full size backpack to hold a 2-pocket folder, schoolwork, and blanket
- Extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks)
- A box of pull-ups, if needed. **Please send in the ones that snap on the sides as it is easier for us to change them. Thanks!**
- A box of diapers, if needed.
- A box of wipes, if needed.

****Toys from home are NOT permitted unless they are specifically requested by the teacher.**

At preschool, we encourage children to build independence, and your support plays an important role in that process. One way you can help is by dressing your child in clothing that is easy for them to manage on their own, such as items they can fasten and unfasten independently. Practicing skills at home like putting on coats, washing hands, opening lunch containers, and cleaning up after activities can also help your child feel more confident and capable at school. Since children stay active throughout the day, please also make sure your child wears comfortable, sturdy shoes to school.
